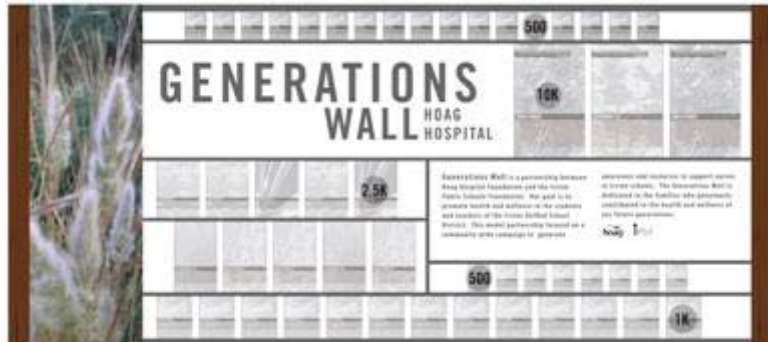
## IPSF 365 Partners Campaign
